

Case Study: Cerner Implementation ICU Devices

Overview:

Barnet Hospital, part of the Royal Free London Group, embarked on a project to upgrade its EPR system to Cerner across its facilities, including the ICU.

Keystream placed a Senior Integrated Technology Consultant to lead the integration of the Cerner system into the ICU. Working within the Digital Devices Team, the consultant's primary task was to link ICU machinery with the Cerner system, automating data collection processes and providing training and support to ICU staff for effective utilisation.

Project Objective

The project aimed to achieve uniformity in EPR systems across the Royal Free London Group, with Barnet Hospital transitioning to the Cerner platform.

The Result

Over the course of 6 months the Cerner system was successfully implemented in Barnet Hospital's ICU in October 2023. The integration streamlined data collection, saving time for healthcare professionals, and enhancing operational efficiency.
